

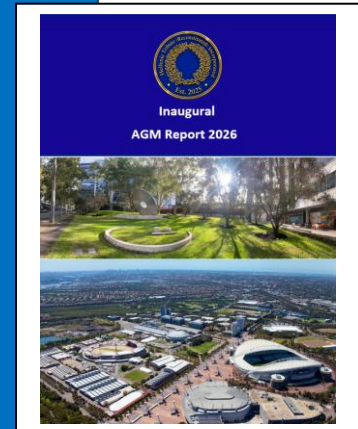

It is with great pleasure, on behalf of the Board of the Hellenic Tribute (Reconstituted) Incorporated, that we present the Association's Inaugural Annual Report 2026.



The Board is immensely proud of the achievements realised since the Association's inaugural meeting on the 9th December 2024.

Of particular significance is the successful reconstitution of the original Hellenic Tribute Incorporated Association, with many current Board members having also served on the original committee between 1996 and 2003. This continuity has enabled the new Association to preserve its original vision in line with the Hellenic Tribute Incorporated Chairman, the late Tasha Vanos OAM JP, while providing renewed leadership and purpose in protecting one of New South Wales's most significant Hellenic cultural landmarks.

On the 13th August 2025, we also reached the 25th Anniversary since the unveiling of the Discobolus Monument and we feature a section in the Annual Report to mark this special milestone and, to once again, thank all contributors for the realisation of this project.

The decision to reconstitute the Hellenic Tribute Incorporated association (following its project completion duties in 2003) was driven by the urgent need to safeguard the Discobolus monument at Stockroute Park, following the release of the draft Sydney Olympic Park (SOP) Master Plan 2050. The proposed rezoning of park land at the site of the monument for future high-density residential development to coincide with associated infrastructure, including a planned Metro station nearby, presented a significant risk to the long-term future of the Discobolus monument and its surrounding mature native tree landscape.

Recognising the importance of preserving this unique cultural asset, the Association undertook an extensive advocacy campaign on behalf of the wider Greek Australian community and the monument's donor sponsors.

Formal submissions objecting to the proposed rezoning affecting Stockroute Park and the Discobolus monument site were lodged with the Sydney Olympic Park Authority (SOPA) and the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, the Hon. Paul Scully MP.

These representations were strongly supported by members of the Greek Australian community who shared our commitment to protecting this modern masterpiece. Formal support was also received from NSW State Members the Hon. Steven Kamper MP, the Hon. Ron Hoenig MP, and Federal Member the Hon. Matt Thistlethwaite MP, whom forwarded letters of support towards our cause to the Minister the Hon. Paul Scully MP.

Following these representations, the Association received formal correspondence from the Hon. Paul Scully MP confirming that the NSW Government's priority remained towards the implementation of the Sydney Olympic Park Master Plan 2050 to facilitate future much needed residential accommodation and supporting transport infrastructure.

With subsequent approval of the Master Plan 2050 by the NSW Government, the future redevelopment of the precinct and relocation of the Discobolus monument became certain. While this outcome represents a significant challenge, the Board remains firmly committed to protecting the integrity, heritage significance and public prominence of the monument alongside the latter protection orders provided by the NSW Heritage Listing of the Discobolus as a Moveable Heritage Item (further details on this achievement below).

The Association will continue to work constructively with SOPA and the NSW Government to explore all options to retain the monument in its current location due to its unique cultural and historical significance, particularly, that the park site was dedicated by the NSW Carr Government at the time for the purpose of this ambitious publicly funded art project raising in the vicinity of \$550,000 in 2000. The location is where the Discobolus was ceremoniously unveiled by His Excellency the Honourable Sir William Deane AC KBE the Governor General of the Commonwealth of Australia, address to the attendees by the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of Australia His Eminence Archbishop Stylianos, and attended by Members of NSW Parliament, the Office of the Minister of the Olympics, Olympic Coordination Authority, Greek Australian community and distinguished members of the public.

The recent establishment of the Hellenic Tribute (Reconstituted) Inc. reflects a long-term commitment to the protection, conservation and promotion of the Discobolus monument. Dedicated to the people of New South Wales as a Hellenic Tribute to the athletes of the Sydney 2000 Olympic and Paralympic Games, the monument represents a significant and unique cultural legacy linking the Olympic host cities of Atlanta (1996), Sydney (2000) and Athens (2004) and diaspora through the Hellenic Tribute Trilogy. It also holds the distinction of being the only Sydney Olympic Park public artwork commissioned for the Sydney 2000 Games to have been fully funded through public donations, distinguishing it from the remaining public art commissions funded by the NSW Government under the Olympic Co-ordination Authority (OCA). The Discobolus art project was also a first to be supported by Greek Australian communities, businesses, and clubs on a national scale.

Foundations

The 2025–2026 period built upon the strong foundations established during the Association's reconstitution. On 12 March 2025, the Hellenic Tribute (Reconstituted) Incorporated was formally registered as an Association, marking the commencement of a new chapter in the stewardship of the Discobolus monument.

Among the Association's most significant achievements during the year was the successful listing of the Discobolus monument as a NSW Moveable Heritage Item and published in the NSW Gazette No. 525 dated 12 December 2025.

This important recognition provides statutory protection for the monument as an individual heritage asset, ensuring that its cultural significance is formally acknowledged and safeguarded in its current present location and should future relocation become necessary.

The Association also established its digital presence through the development and launch of its official website, providing an important platform to communicate the Association's objectives, promote public awareness, and keep stakeholders informed of developments, conservation initiatives and future activities.

Another major focus throughout the year was the inspection of the condition and maintenance of the monument site. Following sustained advocacy and ongoing correspondence to the Hon. Paul Scully MP, the Hon. Steve Kamper MP, the Hon. Mark Buttigieg MLC and Sydney Olympic Park Authority, meaningful progress was achieved during May 2026. As a direct result of these efforts, SOPA recommenced routine maintenance of the monument precinct after a prolonged period of limited site management.

The Board's aim is towards continued engagement with SOPA, including regular site inspections, conservation reporting and ongoing liaison with relevant stakeholders, which is expected to significantly improve the long-term maintenance framework for the monument.

Key Achievements During 2025 – 2026

During the pre and reporting period 2025 – 2026, the Association achieved a number of significant organisational and operational milestones, including:

- Registration of Australian Business Number (ABN 25 287 815 709) on 12 March 2025.
- Formal incorporation (INC 2500325) under the NSW Office of Fair Trading on 12 March 2025.
- Establishment of the Association's Westpac banking facilities on 10 July 2025.
- Successful nomination and approval of the Discobolus Monument as a NSW Moveable Heritage Item, published in the NSW Government Gazette on 12 December 2025.
- Registration of the Association's domain name: www.hellenictribute.com.au
- Design, development and launch of the Association's official website for desktop and mobile platforms.
- Establishment of the Association's official email address: contact@hellenictribute.com.au
- Formal engagement and ongoing liaison established with Sydney Olympic Park Authority management.
- Recommencement of routine maintenance activities at the Discobolus monument site by SOPA.
- Four formal Board meetings conducted during the reporting period, supported by extensive governance, stakeholder engagement and key operational activities undertaken between meetings.

John was a former Councillor and Mayor of Randwick City Council, was instrumental in supporting and advocating for the Discobolus Public Art monument from its inception back in 1999/2000 with the Springtime Greek Glendi Incorporated Association, whom were also Gold Sponsors. John continues to support and advocate the Discobolus monument wherever he can and we greatly appreciate his continued support and input wherever possible.

Looking Ahead

The Board remains committed to building upon the momentum established during the Association's inaugural year.

Over the coming reporting period, the Association's strategic priorities will include continued regular conservation inspections to ensure the Discobolus monument is maintained in accordance with the artist's original design intent, raising public awareness of the monument's historical, cultural and Olympic significance; continuing constructive engagement with SOPA and the NSW Government to advocate for the monument's retention at its current location, work towards the establishment as a "Registered Charity" to strengthen the Association's long-term fundraising capacity and goals towards financially helping future Australian Olympians; and preparing a nomination submission for recognition of the Discobolus monument on this year's heritage theme for the National Heritage List: *Places and related stories that have made a fairer, more inclusive Australia.*

The Board acknowledges the commitment and support of our donors, community organisations and the broader Greek Australian community. Their continued encouragement has been instrumental in the successful re-establishment of the Association and provides a strong foundation for the important work that lies ahead.

On behalf of the Board, we sincerely thank all those who have voluntarily contributed to the achievements of this inaugural year and look forward to continuing our stewardship and celebrate this significant cultural legacy in the heart of Sydney Olympic Park amongst iconic sporting facilities where the first Sydney 2000 Summer Olympic Games were held.

President's Report Nov 2024 to Jun 2025

In Nov 2024, certain previous members of the Hellenic Tribute Incorporated and Hellenic Tribute donors, were alerted to redevelopment plans at Sydney Olympic Park (SOP) precinct and that the Discobolus Monument site at Stockroute Park to be subject to rezoning to allow for high rise development as per the Sydney Olympic Park Authority (SOPA) draft Masterplan 2050.

As a result, past members of the Hellenic Tribute Inc. collectively came together to assess and evaluate the recent developments and to take immediate action accordingly to protect the Discobolus monument at Stockroute Park. The Hellenic Tribute Incorporated (created in 1999) was originally created to facilitate the Discobolus Art-piece works with the NSW Government and Olympic Co-ordination Authority (OCA) as per the Heads of Agreement dated 21/04/1999 and signed by both parties.

Through the generous donations of the Greek Australian community and abroad as well as phil-Hellenes, the project was successfully completed and the unveiling was carried out by the then Governor General of the Commonwealth of Australia, Sir William Deane AC KBE KC on the 13th August 2000 in the presence of Dignitaries, NSW Government Officials, the Australian Hellenic community and phil-Hellenes. It was decided in 2003 by the Hellenic Tribute Inc. committee that the Incorporation cease its registration as the project was completed and no further involvement was required.

The Olympic Co-ordination Authority (OCA) were the official owners and were responsible for the care and maintenance of the Discobolus Art piece monument - "Discus sculpture, Donor stones, Ancient relics, Olive, Cypress and Eucalypt tree surrounds" as per the Heads of Agreement which responsibility have been transferred to SOPA.

In Nov 2024, the SOPA draft Masterplan 2050 was open to public comment which provided details that Stockroute park was sighted as a potential development site.

Previous committee members of the Hellenic Tribute Inc. agreed that the previous Vice Chairman (Vincent Xuereb) lodge a submission in objection and for the committee members to proceed making contact with as many NSW State members to raise our deep concerns and how important the Discobolus monument and site was to the Australian Hellenic Community – being a tribute to the Sydney 2000 Olympic Athletes, to the people of Sydney, as a multi continent Olympic Host City Hellenic Tribute Trilogy (Atlanta 1996 - Sydney 2000 - Athens 2004) and as a permanent Olympic legacy to Sydney Olympic Park. The funds were provided from public donations received from the Australian Hellenic Community and abroad, ultimately raising in the order of \$550,000.

As a result of the latest events taking place in regards to the Discobolus Art Piece monument and surrounds at Stockroute Park it was unanimously agreed by the past living members of the Hellenic Tribute Inc. to reconstitute the Hellenic Tribute Incorporated with NSW Fair Trading.

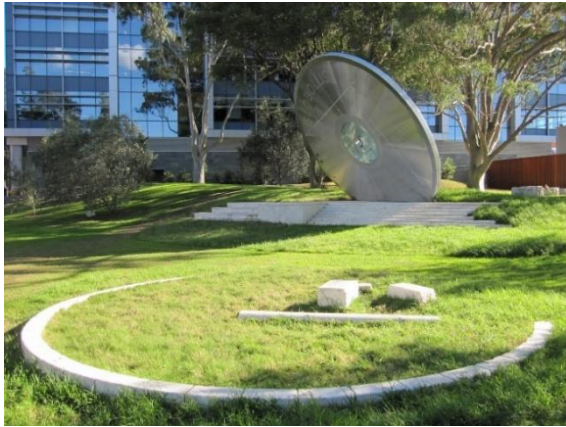
